**Time schedule:** The time schedule will be published at [www.knmv.nl](http://www.knmv.nl). Please note the version date. The rider will receive the latest version at the Welcome Centre.  
**Note:** During the event the schedule can be adjusted.

**Entries:** Registration by e-mail to [c.hijink@knmv.nl](mailto:c.hijink@knmv.nl). Entries and order of admission according to art. 4.1 and 4.1.1 of the KNMV Road racing regulations 2015. Belgian entries, please address the FMB-BMB.

**Bank details KNMV:** competitors will receive an invoice automatically with payment details. All payments have to be transferred on to the bank account the KNMV. Payment in cash at the circuit is also possible

**Technical control:** Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September from 19:00- 21:00 hrs. and Saturday from 08:00 hrs. in pit box 25.

**Transponders:** Transponders can be hired during technical control in the tower at € 25,00 with deposit of € 150,00 and must be returned within 30 minutes after the race.

**Pitboxen:** Pit boxes have to be reserved in advance by e-mail [cecile@cielyourevent.nl](mailto:cecile@cielyourevent.nl) for a rental fee of € 265 for the weekend, to be paid in advance to Ciel Your Event. Without payment the reservation is cancelled.

**Start procedure & finish:** all riders must start all sessions from the pre-grid, Tarzan Corner, next to Hek Noord. Pit box holders can start all session from their pit box.

**Supplementary rules: All classes: Art. 8.3: during the first two laps of the first practice session a fixed yellow flag will be shown on all marshal posts. Overtaking is not allowed.**

### Supplementary technical rules:

The event is organised under a noise standard on the measuring pole of the province at the Circuit Park:

Maximum 95 dB(A) for SBK

Maximum 95 dB(A) for Ducati 3D Cup

Maximum 94 dB(A) for SSP

Maximum 90 dB(A) for KTM RC Cup

Maximum 91 dB(A) for Moriwaki 250 Junior Cup

To accomplish this, we recommend that all riders use an original exhaust system or an after-market system where the silencer is required with a sound and correct assembled dB-killer, at least 5 cm in length, designed for that after-market system. It is also required to use the original air filter element into the air filter. It is also advised to coat the inside of the fairing with foam. This all in order to meet the noise standards.

**Penalties:** On Saturday one warning will be given. At the second violation on Saturday or any violation on Sunday the rider will be disqualified.

**Environment:** Work on motorcycles is only allowed in the paddock or pit lane. The use of an environmental mat in the paddock is compulsory. All waste oil should be disposed in the provided wast-oil-containers. It is not allowed to leave tires behind on the track or its grounds. These rules are strictly monitored in the paddock.

**Price giving ceremony:** There will be cups for the first 3 riders of every class and race, presented directly after each race

**Other:** Pets and mini bikes are not allowed in the paddock. No unauthorized persons and children under 16 (expect for riders) are allowed in the pit lane during practice and races. From 22:00 hrs to 07:00 hrs impotunity and noise is not allowed in the paddock. See for further info the paddock house rules of Circuit Park Zandvoort.

**Liability:** De KNMV nor Ciel Your Event can be held responsible for any damage to motorcycles, accessories, spare parts, personal injuries, property damage and consequential damage, caused by an accident, fire of by a competitor and/or accompanying persons.

**Final provision:** These road races are organised by the Ciel Your Event according to the ONK road racing and technical regulations 2015 and sporting code 2015 of the KNMV. By registering the rider is deemed to know and respect these regulations. In case of any differences in interpretation or translation of the English SR in comparison to the Dutch SR, the Dutch SR will be leading.
