Pass System: all teams and riders will receive TT Circuit Assen admission and BSB worker credentials at the welcome centre on arrival. Further details will be given to the riders through a Final Instructions document.

Time schedule: the time schedule will be published at www.knmv.nl. The rider will receive the latest version at the Welcome Centre. **Note:** during the event the schedule can be adjusted.

Bank details KNMV: competitors will receive an invoice automatically with payment details. All payments have to be transferred on to the bank account of the KNMV before the start of the event.

Pit boxes: not available

Technical control: Thursday 18.00 – 20.00 hrs and Friday 08.00 – 09.00 hrs.

House rules of the TT Circuit Assen: the rider and his team members are deemed to know and respect these rules. A copy is available at Riders Info on request. It is not allowed to leave tires behind on the track or its grounds. Violation is punishable by a fine of €50.- per tyre. Accessing the track with a motorized vehicle, outside of the practice sessions or races, is not allowed under penalty of a fine of €100.- per violation. These penalties will be imposed by the organiser. In addition to the fine the organiser may refer the violation of the rider and/or his team members to the jury.

Other: there will be two (2) combined races for BeNeCup/BK. The starting grid is based on the qualification times, with random arrangement of classes. At registration the riders have to indicate for which competition they will be riding, either Supersport or Superbikes.

The GP Ruskenhoek layout will be applicable for this race.

The start procedure for BeNeCup/BK will be according to art. 8.8 of the KNMV Road racing regulations 2018. **There will be two warm up laps.** The pit lane is forbidden for unauthorized persons and children younger than 16 years (except riders). Helpers have to enter the pit lane through the gate between the timekeeping building and the parc fermé. Entering through the parc fermé is prohibited.

All riders must assemble for the start of practices and start the sighting lap from the pre-grid zone. The location of the pre-grid zone will be at the paddock next to pit box 34. At the end of any session all riders must leave the track via the Techno Centre.

When a rider does not qualify, or is excluded from participating for any other reason, no refund will be given.

In the event of a rider falling – it is not authorised to continue in the practice or race until the motorcycle is checked at the Techno Centre.

Results for BeNeCup: According KNMV road race regulations 2018. Competitors should be in conformity with the KNMV technical regulations to be classified. Guest riders with KNMV one event license will not achieve points for the BeNeCup Championship.

Prize giving ceremony: there will be trophies for the first 3 finishers, for BeNeCup Supersport and BeNeCup Superbike each, presented on the podium in the pit lane. **As this is the final race for the BeNeCup Championship, there will be an additional prize giving for the numbers 1,2 and 3 of the BeNeCup Superbikes and the BeNeCup Supersport Championship, on the podium in the pit lane.**

Final determination: With permission from the KNMV this event is organised by MotorSport Vision Racing Limited under the Permit, Sporting Code, and General Regulations of the Motorcycle Circuit Racing Control Board which can be viewed at www.msvracing.co.uk/bsb. The MCRCB and MSVR will adopt the 2018 KNMV Sporting Code, the KNMV road racing & technical regulations for the ONK SBK and SSP save for any specific matters stated in these SRs. By registering the rider is deemed to know and respect these regulations.
